## ABOUT

The Animal Behavior and Welfare (ABW) bachelor's program has a duration of **4 years** with teaching in **English**. It combines theoretical knowledge with procedural ones, aiming to facilitate the understanding of the ways animals behave in various contexts and to help them as future graduates to respond in an ethical and responsible way to the challenges that animals face when living in a captive or wild environment, preventing negative interactions.

The ABW program is designed around a **multi-disciplinary, research-driven approach** to the study and teaching of animal behavior and welfare (companion, farm, and wild animals), animal cognition, and emotions, empowering the students with a solid foundation in animal biology, ecology and conservation, as well as, animal genetics and psychology.

The connection between learning experiences and the needs of the community is assured by the inclusion in the curricula of a **Service-Learning course**.
